NOTICE

In Accordance with Chief Justice Melton's Order Declaring Statewide Judicial Emergency (dated March 14, 2020) the Toombs County Clerk of Court Office is open only for essential business until April 13th, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. unless otherwise extended. Essential court is determined as 1) where an immediate liberty or safety concern is present requiring the attention of the court as soon as the court is available; 2) criminal search warrants, arrest warrants, initial appearances, and bond reviews; 3) domestic abuse temporary protective orders and restraining orders; 4) juvenile court delinquency detention hearings, and emergency removal matters (Local Order (dated March 18, 2020) clarifies: 1. Detention hearing in delinquency cases; 2. Continued custody hearings in CHINS cases; 3. Emergency removal matters in dependency cases; 4. Preliminary protective hearings in dependency cases; and 5. Any delinquency case in which the juvenile's liberty is at stake) and 5) mental health commitment hearings. If you have any questions or concerns about your court case please contact your Attorney.

The Clerk of Courts will be staffed Monday –Friday (8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)

NOTE: Title searchers/Abstractors will be let in depending on vault traffic and you may be asked to wait for a few minutes, as our vaults are not large in size. (Title searchers/Abstractors may want to call before coming to the courthouse.)
