The following functions have been deemed essential pertaining to the Probate Court of Toombs County:

- 1) Filings & requests must be submitted electronically at tslindsey.tpc@yahoo.com or dstripling.tpc@yahoo.com
- 2) Emergency guardianship/conservatorship
- 3) Orders to Apprehend (OTAs)
- 4) Other legitimate emergency petitions or motions
- 5) Vital records/death (Funeral Home with continue to fax in request)
- 6) Marriage license (only if wedding during the time we are under a statewide judicial emergency)

The following functions have been temporarily suspended: Notary public services, applications of Weapons Carry Licenses and Renewals pursuant to an Order of the Supreme Court of Georgia declaring a Judicial Emergency due to COVID-19. If you are due to renew your license during the emergency period, your license will not expire. You will be able to renew after the emergency period ends, and your current license will remain valid until that time. ***see bottom of page for further explanation***
