

CALLED BOARD MEETING

Call to Order: Chairman Sikes called the Called Board Meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Invocation: Commissioner Cason gave the Invocation.

Approve Agenda: Chairman Sikes asked for a motion to approve the Agenda.

Commissioner Cason made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Nobles to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

**Consideration of
Approval of Resolution
Approving County
Millage Rate:** Manager Jones stated copy of the resolution was in the packet. Total Tax Digest is \$ 809,285,345, purposed a gross millage rate of 10.8348 mills, the rollback of the Local Option Sales Tax 2.7948 mills and the net millage rate of 8.040 for the tax year of 2022. Management recommends the board set the gross and net millage rate so stated.

Vice-Chairman Rollins made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Nobles to approve the Chairman to sign the resolution to set a gross millage rate of 10.8348; the net millage rate is set at 8.040. Motion carried unanimously.

**Consideration of
Approval of Resolution
Approving Toombs
County Development
Authority Millage Rate:** Manager Jones stated there was a Referendum pass many years ago, to set a millage rate of 1.000 mill for the Development Authority and as such, the board was asked to approve the resolution so that 1.000 mill can be levied.

Commissioner Nobles made a motion, seconded by Vice-Chairman Rollins to approve the Chairman to sign the Resolution to levy a tax of 1.000 Mill for the Development Authority. Motion carried unanimously.

**Consideration for Approval
of Resolution Approving
the Toombs County Board
of Education Millage Rate:** Manager Jones stated Toombs County is the only one that can levy tax. Included in the packet there was the computation of the Toombs County Board of Education purposed millage rate and the board minutes where they approved the purposed millage rate of 14.370 mills for the purpose of Education on behalf of Toombs County Board of Education. Management recommended the Board to approve a levy of 14.370 millage rate that was requested by the County's School Board.

Commissioners Nobles made a motion, seconded by Vice-Chairman Rollins to approve the Resolution to levy a tax of 14.370 Mills on behalf of the Toombs County Board of Education. Motion carried unanimously.

Adjournment: Chairman Sikes asked for a motion to adjourn from the Called Board Meeting.

Vice-Chairman Rollins made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cason to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
